

COVID-19 Announcements

*Due to COVID 19 we will be following CDC recommended guidelines for spaced out seating which will limit the number of students we can receive. Hand washing with antibacterial soaps will take place at set times as well as occasional hand sanitizer usage during the day. Personal containment of pencils and supplies need to be kept with each student and we request they not be shared. Any studio supplies communally used shall be sterilized as well as tables and multi touch surfaces throughout the day.

**To keep safety up and limit numbers, we are requesting parents to stay in their car when picking up children, place their provided full page name tag in their dash and park near the building, then text that they are ready for the student to come out. Classes may be taken individually, and we need to keep a vigilant eye on who is coming and going. Front door may be locked during classes but not in between.

***If your student is enrolled in Epic Charter Schools and public schools shut down, Epic will halt all funding for *in person* classes. You have options if that happens:

Continue to have Epic cover costs *via online classes through Zoom* and turning in the coursework weekly.

Continue to attend in person classes and pay privately for those. If you need to adjust the class load for financial reasons, the student may finish out the month that has been paid for prior to adjusting.

You have the choice to unenroll if neither option works for you.

****The way a City Mask Mandate affects the co-op is minimal. Inside our facility, we are keeping classes small enough to social distance, therefore, they are not required. In situations like group projects or buddy dissections, students will need a mask for those situations regardless of a mask mandate or not as we would not be able to distance in that situation and would like to keep everyone safe.
